



RA Taboo & Pictionary Competition Rules

A maximum of 7 groups will participate in the competition. Each group will consist of 3 people. The competition will consist of two rounds:

First Round:

All groups will compete in order.

This round includes two main sections: a) TABOO b) Pictionary

3 groups with the highest combined score from these sections will advance to the final.

TABOO rules:

One person from each group will explain words to their group without using forbidden words and expressions.

Using foreign language is prohibited.

Time limit: 2 minutes

Scoring: 1 point for each correctly guessed word

Maximum 3 words can be passed

PICTIONARY rules:

A person from each group will draw the ultrasound image of the asked anatomical structure in a specific block to explain to their group (e.g. dorsal scapular nerve in the interscalene block)

It is expected to draw an ultrasound image.

At least 3 anatomical structures must be drawn.

Writing and speaking are prohibited.

Time limit: 2 minutes

Scoring: 1 point for each correctly guessed question

In case of a tie after summing up TABOO and PICTONARY scores, sonoanatomy images will be shown until the tie is broken.

Final Round:

One person from each group will be asked to show an anatomical structure in a specific block on the ultrasound on a live model (e.g. dorsal scapular nerve in the interscalene block). Time limit for demonstration: 2 minutes

All other participants will try to guess the anatomical structure from the obtained ultrasound image.

Time limit for guessing: 1 minute

Scoring:

1 point for correctly demonstrating the structure on the model

1 point for correctly guessing the structure from the ultrasound image

-1 point if the structure is not shown correctly on the model

If a different structure is demonstrated, the obtained ultrasound image will still be shown to groups for guessing. And 1 point will be given for correctly guessing the structure from the ultrasound image.

After 1 round, the group with the highest score wins the competition.

In case of a tie, the competition will continue until the tie is broken.

The competitors should be trainees, but everyone is welcome to watch and have lots of fun at this tremendous & joyful competition. The winning team of three will have “the prize.”
