Was the first recorded use of acupuncture in medicine. Its useful healing properties spread westward along trade routes originating in China

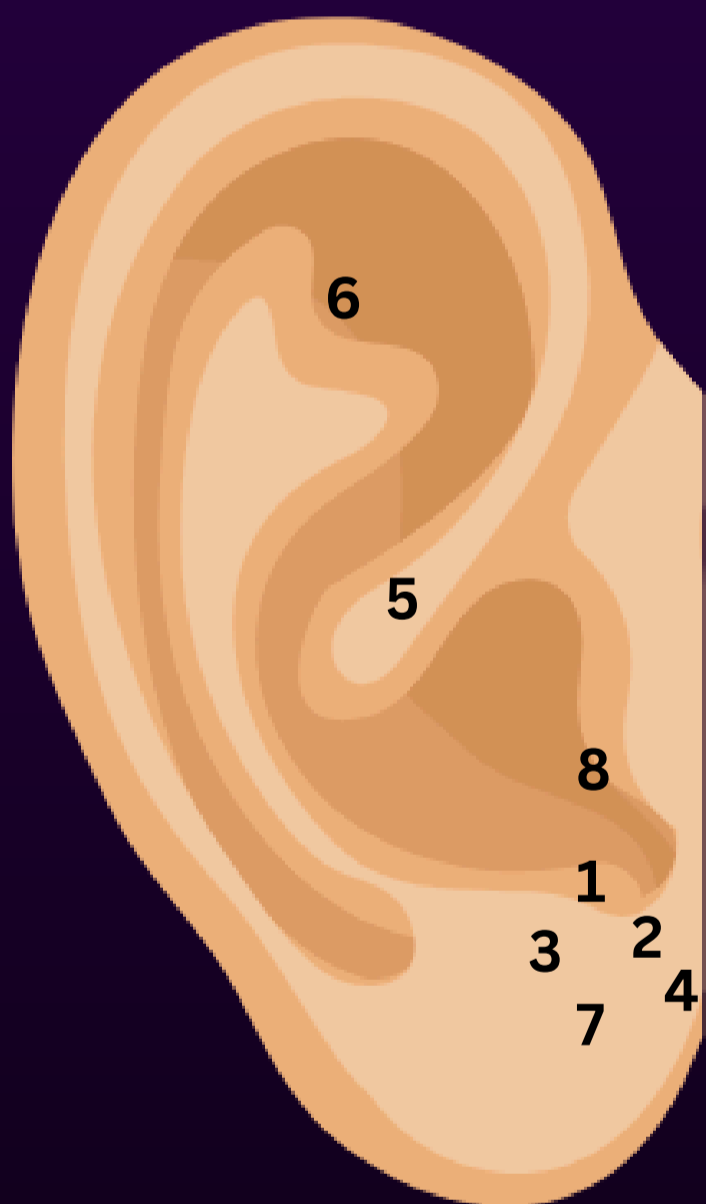
## Acupuncture in the Operating Room

Acupuncture can be implemented during surgery to help patients with:

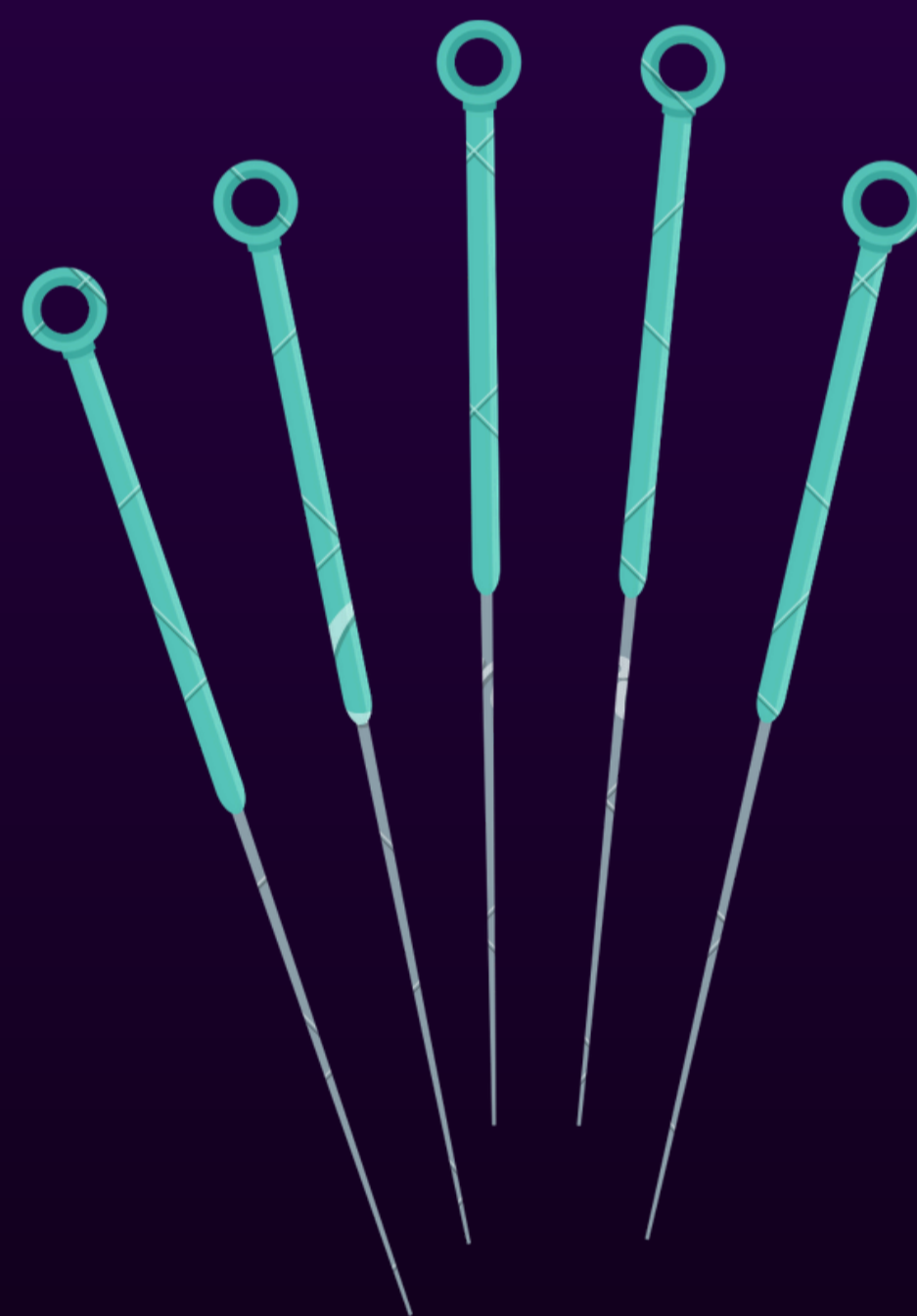
- Pain Relief

1. Hypothalamus
2. Amygdala
3. Hippocampus
4. Prefrontal Cortex
5. Point Zero
6. Shen Men
7. Insula
8. Vagus



## Timeline

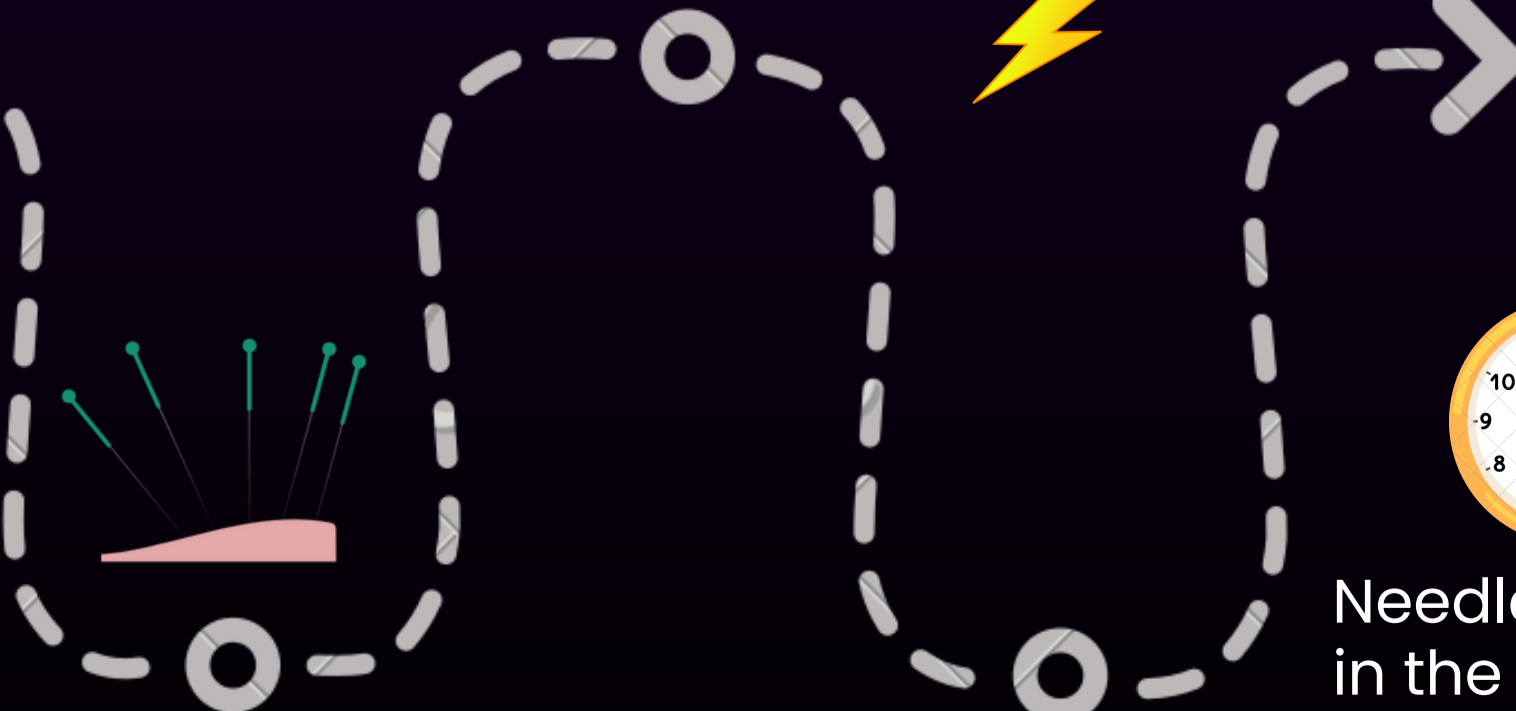
Patient is induced for surgery



Needles are connected to 30Hz



Acupuncture needles are placed



Needles remain in the ear for 60 min
